GUITAR LESSONS: BEGINNER

Tuesdays, 2–2:30 p.m.

This class is for those brand new to guitar. Instruction will include how to hold and tune a guitar, proper chord and pick positioning, basic strumming, and changing between chords. If you have never played the guitar or have questions, contact Bob Claymier at 740-816-9627 before you register to learn more or to schedule private lessons. If you need help finding a guitar, let Bob know. You will need one before the class starts.

GUITAR LESSONS: ADVANCED BEGINNER

Tuesdays, 2:30–3 p.m.

This group will know basic chords and a few strumming patterns and will work on becoming more proficient at changing chords, learning more chords, beginning fingerpicking, and different strum patterns.

GUITAR LESSONS:

INTERMEDIATE

Tuesdays, 3–3:30 p.m.

Each session will have the same instruction and will cover advanced strum patterns, fingerpicking, and simple riffs for selected songs. You suggest the songs you want to learn and we'll play them!

GUITAR LESSONS: EXPLORING THE FRETBOARD

ADVENTURES IN ABSTRACT ART: ALCOHOL INK COLLAGE

RETURNING

Use alcohol ink to create abstract art on photo paper, then cut the paper and piece together a unique collage on 8x8 wood cradle board. We will complete the piece by applying a coat of resin for a shiny finish. Instructor Carol Wallenfelsz will guide you through this process.

GELLI PLATE PRINTING: MAGAZINE TRANSFERS AND WAX RESIST *NEW!*

Explore and experiment with gelli plate printing. Learn how to transfer magazine images and how to create textured images using stencils and crayons wax resist techniques. The designs you will make are perfect for turning into cards or integrating into mixed media art. Instructor Carol Wallenfelsz will guide you through this process.

WOODCARVING: INTRO TO
INTARSIA *NEW!***

Thursdays, Sept. 4, 11, 25, Oct. 2, 9:30–11:30 a.m. (No class on Sept. 18.)

Intarsia is a mosaic of wood fitted and glued together onto a wooden support. Led by woodcarver Chuck Laurence, this class includes a discussion of the intarsia process from the selection of a pattern, types of wood, the cutting out of the wood, glueing, and finishing the completed project. In addition, the student will create an intarsia angel from the materials provided. An N95 dust mask is required to wear during wood sanding.
