WOODCARVING: DOUBLE-SIDED HOLIDAY ORNAMENT *NEW!*

Thursdays, Oct. 9 through 30, 9:30–11:30 a.m.

Join woodcarver Steve Schmidt as he guides you through creating a Double-sided Holiday Ornament. This class is recommended for students with some woodcarving experience. The class will focus on fundamental cuts using woodcarving knives and gouges, as well as focusing on safety. Each student will be given a pattern for a turkey and a Santa, and the opportunity to create one or both on opposite sides of the ornament. Wood blanks will be provided for this class. Carving tools will be available for use through SourcePoint. Students are welcome to bring their own carving tools. All students must provide their own cut resistant gloves (minimum A4 or A5 cut resistance is recommended).
