BOOMWHACKERS

Wednesdays, Sept. 8 and 15, 12:30–1:30 p.m.

A boomwhacker is a lightweight, hollow, color-coded plastic tube, tuned to a musical pitch by length.

Boomwhackers are used as musical instruments in the percussion family. Musician and retired school music teacher, Peggy Hawse, facilitates this group. Her philosophy is that music should be for everyone and it should be fun!

PAPER QUILLING: FALL FLOWER *NEW!*

Crafter Sue Workman leads you through the steps of paper quilling to complete a fall flower. Supplies provided. Use our tools.
