GUITAR LESSONS: BEGINNER Tuesdays through Dec. 17, 2–2:30 p.m.

This class is for those brand new to guitar. Instruction will include how to hold and tune a guitar, proper chord and pick positioning, basic strumming, and changing between chords. If you have never played the guitar or have questions, contact Bob Claymier at 740-816-9627 before you register to learn more or to schedule private lessons. If you need help finding a guitar, let Bob know. You will need one before the class starts.

GUITAR LESSONS: ADVANCED BEGINNER Tuesdays through Dec. 17,

2:30–3 p.m.

This group will know basic chords and a few strumming patterns and will work on becoming more proficient at changing chords, learning more chords, beginning fingerpicking, and different strum patterns. This class has a designated group practice time, Mondays, 1-1:30 p.m.

GUITAR LESSONS: INTERMEDIATE

WOODCARVING: ADVANCED HUMAN FACE *NEW!*

Interact with fellow experienced carvers of varying levels while creating a human facial piece. Class will be facilitated by Keith Radick. Study the basics of facial proportions and individual element details. This will be accomplished in the carvers' creation of a human full face in a basswood block (pay instructor \$10). As this is an advanced class, carvers are expected to provide their own tools and personal protective equipment (principally cut-resistant gloves).

Prerequisites for this class are completion of the SourcePoint Basic and Intermediate carving classes. Any exceptions will be on a case-by-case basis at the sole discretion of the instructor.

The pressure to draw an exact likeness of an object is removed as we explore these two techniques.

We will finish our 9x12 drawings with colored pencils. Instructor Carol Wallenfelsz will guide you through this process.
